Click on **"Proceed to eService"** to start the application process.

If you are not sure if you are able to use the eService, click on **"Run Eligibility Check"**

You will be notified when your spouse responds.

Click **"File for divorce"** eService
Submit divorce papers

Once all information has been filled up, a discussion document will be sent to your spouse.

If your spouse is agreeable to the divorce and the other ancillary matters (relating to the child issues, maintenance and division of assets), you will be allowed to continue with the filing of the divorce application and payment of the filing fees can be made online.

If your spouse is not agreeable to the divorce and/or the ancillary matters, or if you are unable to complete the application on your own, you can approach the following for assistance:

NOTE : If you do not complete the application, your application is automatically saved in the system for 90 days and you can always log in to complete the process.

Documents to prepare

- Marriage certificate (if the marriage was not solemnised in Singapore)
- Deed Poll (if the name reflected in the marriage certificate is different from your name)
- CPF Public Housing Withdrawal Statement (if there is no agreement on how your HDB flat is to be dealt with)
- Bankruptcy Search Results on both spouses
